WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ☐ Undergraduate students who are learning at a partner university with KMOU as a full-time matriculated student and proficient in English.

☐ NOTES

- Students who have never learned Korean can also apply if they have sufficient command of English.
- As shown in Application Procedure, KMOU select candidates IF the number of total applicants exceeds 50.
- Graduate Students are not eligible for this program.



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- ➊ Contact the International Office of your university and get an application form.
- ➋ Fill out the form and submit it to the international office of YOUR university before the deadline that the office set.
※ Deadline from your home university to KMOU: April 27(FRI), 2018
- ➌ If the total number of applicants exceeds 50, KMOU will select final attendees from the applicants according to the nomination by the international office of your university.
- ➍ After the selection, a Certificate of Admission for each attendee will be issued.
- ➎ You need to apply for a visa(D-2-6, Exchange Student Visa) at the Korean Embassy or Consulate in your country.

PROGRAM FEES

- ☐ Students from *partner universities* : KRW 400,000
 - Accomodations and Meals : KRW 200,000
 - Korean & Special Lectures : KRW 200,000
 - Payment shall be made upon arrival at Korea, in Korean Won.
- ☐ Students from *AMFUF member institutions* : FREE
- ☐ KMOU will bear the fees for all cultural excursions, welcome and farewell ceremony, etc.
- ☐ Please note that the travel expenses to/from Korea, and expenses of buying overseas travel insurance(illness, injury and indemnity).
